"Ella Enchanted" helmer Tommy O'Haver has come aboard to direct Hart Sharp Entertainment's "Breakfast With Tiffany," based on the memoir of the same name by Edwin John Wintle.

O'Haver and Irene Turner will adapt the book for film.

Pic follows Wintle's journey from single, middle-aged gay New Yorker to unexpected guardian of his troubled 13-year-old niece, Tiffany.

Wintle is exec producing the pic, which is being produced and financed through Hart Sharp and its equity-backed True Film Fund II.

"Tiffany" was published in June by Miramax Books.

Simon & Schuster rolled out the
